*A part of you*


While I definitely think you have to "find" your purpose, it isn't really a search because it has always been a part of you.

We all have two versions of ourselves inside.


1. The original version created in God's image-- that God knows us as

Are there things or qualities inside of you that you don't particularly see as a "bad thing" but other people do?


*those are your gifts!*

What fuels you?


What do you enjoy and always find refreshing?

## Task #4


### Who are you influenced by?

After watching how they influenced me, it was my job to manifest that myself in my own life.


So within your niche, who influences you? In a good way of course!

2. Write down your vision in plain words and figure out what you need to do to achieve it!




You are not late, you have not missed your blessing, you are right where God wants you to be but you must walk WITH GOD- not ask him to walk with you and the plans that you have made for yourself!
